

Concordia R-2 Booster Club 2022-2023 Information

The purpose of the Concordia R-2 Booster Club is organized solely for the purpose of promoting curricular and extra-curricular activities of Concordia Junior/Senior High School. Curricular activities refer to any activity associated with any class at Concordia Junior/Senior High School. Extra-curricular activities are comprised of the athletic program, the music program and any other activity approved by the school board. The curricular and/or extra-curricular activities described above will hereafter be referred to as the "programs."

What we do is provide support and raise money for our students' activities. We do this through membership dues, program advertisement sales, business sponsorships and fundraisers.

What do I do to join?

The Booster Club encourages all junior high and senior parents to become members. To join, simply fill out the registration form and pay your dues. Membership levels include Individual, Family and Business. Registration forms are sent home with students at the beginning of each school year. They are also available at the first home volleyball, football and basketball games for junior and senior high. The forms are also available on the Booster Club website (under the Parents tab at www.concordia.k12.mo.us).

How can I help out?

After becoming a member, the most important thing you can do is attend the two member's meetings held during the year. One is held in the fall and one in the spring. At the meetings, you can learn how to volunteer to serve on one of the committees. As a member, you are also eligible to vote and hold office.

As a member, what do I get?

Each family joins as one. With your membership dues and registration, two adults will become voting members of the Booster Club. You are also entitled to **half-price admission** to all junior and senior high school regular-season home athletic events (this excludes tournaments). All you need to do is present your membership card at the admission gate. A list will also be kept at the gate if you do not have your card.

What has the Booster Club done lately?

Besides organizing Fall, Winter and Spring Athletic Banquets and the Band Banquet the Booster Club has financially supported the following: Band uniforms, basketball gun shooting machine, football goal posts, Homecoming activities, classroom books, honor cords and sashes for graduates, CHS Yearbook, drum major uniforms, calculators, stoves, sewing machines, track canopy, golf equipment, football helmets, baseball & softball bats, sheet music, weight lifting equipment, music contest entry fees, FLBA expenses, PE supplies, banners, signs, baseball games at Royals stadium and much more. We are also a proud sponsor of the Meals of Hope organized by our own FFA.

What does each committee do?

All of our committees have a similar structure. There are parent representatives for each grade of student, 7-12. A chair is elected and becomes a member of the Executive Committee.

The *Executive Committee* consists of the President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Past President and the chairs of the Standing Committees.

The *Program Committee* solicits advertisements for the printed programs that we pass out at athletic events. This group meets about twice a year and provides for a portion of our fundraising. This committee needs outgoing volunteers that are able to make contact with businesses in and around Concordia.

The *Fireworks Committee* is in charge of organizing the Booster Club's fireworks sales. The event takes place at the beginning of July.

The *Membership Committee* is recruits and registers members. They issue membership cards to all members.

The *Band Committee* is in charge of organizing the Band Banquet this is usually held at the end of the marching season. There are special projects involved including arranging for meals for the band at marching contests in the fall.

The *Athletic Banquets Committee* is responsible for planning and organizing the fall, winter and spring athletic banquets. These are three separate groups of parents.
