Warmer Weather and the Dress Code

As the weather gets warmer, students begin to dress for the weather. Many folks find out that the clothes that fit back in September, don't always fit in the springtime. Here are some reminders about the dress code. The full dress code can be found in the Student/Parent Handbook. Shorts are allowed and must be mid-thigh length or longer. A good general rule of thumb is that they should be finger-tip length. Shirts should cover the middle of the body and should overlap with shorts or pants. Students are free to wear flip-flops or other backless footwear, but they will not be allowed to participate in PE class or at recess. Many injuries occur with this type of footwear.

Last Days Of School Information

The end of the school year is rapidly approaching and there are many details of which parents and students should be aware. Here is a list of the most important things to keep in mind.

- All students will take a Reading placement test at the end of the year. Most students will not require extra Reading services during Summer School. Parents and students will be notified if further services are required.
- Grade Reports will be sent home with the students on Thursday, May 18.
- Parents are asked to make sure all meal balances are paid by May 18. If your student has a positive balance, we will roll that over to next year unless you request a refund.



- The last day of school for the year will be Friday, May 19. School will be dismissed at 11:40 that day. Only Breakfast will be served on the last day of school.
- The CES Parent Teacher Organization will sponsor a Field Day on May 19. The students will be outside most of the morning enjoying games and activities. Be sure your students are dressed appropriately for the weather.
- Check with your students about library books that may be out. Students are welcome to attend field day and class field trips when all library matters are settled.
- Preschool parents should make sure that all fees have been paid.
