New Kindergartener Enrollment and Preschool Screening days scheduled at CES: MAY 14 and May 16, 2018

Kindergarten:

If you have a child who will be five (5) years old by August 1, 2018, and is not currently enrolled in CES preschool, we would like to hear from you to enroll them on May 14th Or May 16th.

Please call the school office at 660-463-2261 to schedule an appointment. Check-in and enrollment information will be available in the school office on these dates.

Parents, this is an opportunity to enroll students who are new to our district for Kindergarten 2018. We will also be doing testing to help prepare your child for success. The testing will include: vision, hearing, dyslexia screening and Dial IV. There will also be Parents as Teachers (PAT) information and sign-up available.

Preschool:

If your child is already a preschooler with our district, we will be doing this enrollment through preschool classes, so you need not contact us.

If your child is going to be age three (3) or four (4) by August 1, 2018. We will be accepting applications for enrollment for the 2018 3-yearold preschool class as well as the 2018 4-yearold class. There will also be screening for the new 4-year-olds to include: vision, hearing, dyslexia screening and Dial IV. Please call the school office at 660-463-2261 to schedule an appointment. Check-in and enrollment information will be available in the school office on these dates.

Additionally, there will be information for Parents as Teachers (PAT) available, and our new PAT provider Hailee Brown will be there to take your information.

Parents, this is an opportunity to enroll for preschool, get to know us here at the Concordia Elementary and ask any questions you might have. We hope you will contact us to find out if you want to pursue enrollment in our preschool program for your child next year, whether they would be 3 or 4-year-old pre-school students.



Summer School 2018: Summer School is just around the corner and it is not too early to mark your calendars! This year, our summer session will run from Monday, June 4th through Friday, June 22nd.

If you have been contacted by your child's teacher regarding grades the last month, we strongly encourage you to enroll your student. The deadline for enrollment is this Friday 5/4, so please hurry to enroll.
