### *A few polishing tips!*

- Be THOROUGH - Give yourself adequate time to write your essay. Rushing though it will result in submitting less than your best work; consequently, your application not being selected.
- BE PRECISE - For every idea you present, make sure you can back it up with examples and specifics. Being too vague or general may demonstrate to the review committee that, while although you have solid ideas, you cannot elaborate on them or did not take the time to do so.
