

## Building Oriole Strong—One Brick at a Time

CHS has beautifully completed the football courtyard the summer of 2013. As an extra feature, an outlined C is inlaid with red bricks in the cemented courtyard between the concession stand and the football field bleachers.

Specially engraved bricks may be designed and purchased to place in this outlined C.



This is an unique way to "leave a lasting impression" or to honor people who have been associated with the Concordia R-2 School District. This is a chance for students, alumni, teachers, and patrons of the district to show their school spirit.

Over 60 bricks have already been ordered and installed in the courtyard. Take time to check out the courtyard!

Some ideas of information to have engraved in the bricks are names of students, names of families, years attended school, year graduated, sports and activities involved in, special memories, etc.

This project is a combination of site beautification, recognition, and community building which has become a main purpose of the Oriole Strong program at Concordia R-2. The attractiveness and permanence of the installed engraved brick courtyard will be enjoyed for years to come.

The bricks are red, and the brick engraving company guarantees all the letters and the filler in the engraved area for the life of the brick. The proprietary filler guarantees permanent legibility with no deterioration or collection of dirt or debris in the letters. The actual depth of the engraving is 1/8" to 1/4" deep before the filler is inserted into the letters.

Each brick surface can be engraved with three lines of text with 15 characters per line. (See examples at the right of bricks already installed.)

The total number of bricks in the courtyard is 398 with 332 bricks in the outside circle and 66 bricks in the C.

The price per each personalized brick is \$75; checks should be made payable to Concordia R-2 Schools.
