individuals also wear a mask. The District will also consider other arrangements, such as a temporary assignment for such staff to avoid being within six feet of other individuals.

- 6. The temperature of asymptomatic staff members exposed to COVID-19 positive individuals must be monitored and symptoms assessed prior to starting work each day, ideally before entering the facility, for at least 14 days from the date of exposure.
- 7. Upon noticing any signs of illness prior to coming to work, including a temperature of 100.4° or above, the staff must stay home.
- 8. This resolution and these requirements do not apply to sick and/or confirmed COVID-19 positive staff.
- 9. Each case of asymptomatic staff members exposed to COVID-19 positive individuals or COVID-19 positive staff will be reviewed before a determination is made on when such staff member may return to work and the safety measures that will be taken.
- 10. Asymptomatic staff members exposed to a COVID-19 positive individual(s) and who are not COVID-19 positive will have the discretion of returning to work for 7 days after a minimum quarantine for 7 days.
